

Speedway Spectacular 2010

Allison Transmission joins with The Greater Speedway Area Chamber of Commerce, Speedway Lions Club, Speedway Optimists Club and the Speedway Trails Association to put on the Speedway Spectacular scheduled for Saturday, Sept. 18th at Leonard Park

The Speedway Spectacular is a one day event that begins with a Bike, Run, Walk event that raises money for the Speedway Trails Association starting at 9:00. A Parade will follow at 11:00—ending at Leonard Park where a fall festival will be taking place. The festival will include a safety fair, kids zone, corn hole tournaments, music and a chili cook off. The corn hole tournament registration/ practice at 12:30, tournament at 1:00. \$25 registration fee per team. The tournament will consist of up to 36 team with \$200 for first place and \$100 for second place. The chili cook off is open to all. There is a \$10 fee for individuals and \$20 for corporations to participate. Participants can enter in a mild or hot category. Judging begins at 12:30 and public tasting at 1:00. A panel of judges will pick the winners and award first place \$100, 2nd place-\$50. The public can vote for their favorite chili by purchasing tickets and voting with their tickets. \$25 will be awarded to the fan favorite. A beer garden will be set up in the chili cook off area, as well as a tent to view college football games and play cards.

Local service organizations and vendors will have booths set up to pass out educational information and sell products.

The kids zone activities will begin at 12:30- Pumpkin painting by Old Farm Market, carnival games, and a blow up slide.
